The UCCP looks for a theological lecturer holding a Ph.D./Th.D. for teaching New Testament, giving lectures, seminars and tutorials as well as offering scientific support and care to the students. English is the working language.

Your responsibilities will include:

- develop a more international (cross-cultural) and ecumenical linkage of the programs
- implement new modes of teaching-learning methodologies
- evaluate the curricular work-load requirements

- ordained theologian Ph.D./Th.D. with working experience in a local congregation
- age between 45 to 60 years
- proven experience in teaching theology on an academic level
- preferably with ecumenical experience and spiritual competence

The secondment will be for a 3 years period. Extension for a second term may be considered.
