Invitation to the UEM online lecture with Rev. Dr. Susanne Wolf

(Wuppertal, 17 August 2026) The United Evangelical Mission (UEM) invites to an two-hour English online lecture on 25 August 2026 as part of its “Global Education” series.

Under the title “Teaching and Learning ‘Attitudes’: Challenge and Chance in Global Education,” Rev. Dr. Susanne Wolf – Director of the Joint Pastoral Training Centre for Continuing Education of the Evangelical Church in the Rhineland, the Evangelical Church of Westphalia, the Lippe Church and the Evangelical Reformed Church – will explore how an open-minded and empathetic attitude can be fostered in an international educational context.

UEM’s “Global Education” lecture series brings together intercultural learning, critical thinking and sustainability, equipping people to navigate an interconnected world. Participants reflect on the significance of spirituality, positionality and attitude for personal development. Another focus is on exploring educational approaches that initiate change and create fertile ground for encounters on an equal footing. The lecture will alternate with interactive discussion sessions.
