Content

Identify one or two challenges that you think need to be addressed in your context in relation to discrimination, racism and various forms violence within Churches, Diaconia and society.

Include in your paper:

- o Description of the challenge
- o Empirical and/or literature/theoretical analysis
- Theological reflection
- o Individual findings, goals, possible options and obstacles
- o Recommendations a) to your church and b) to the UEM communion

Your English-language paper should consist of approximately 18.000 characters (no spaces) including footnotes (altogether up to 6 pages with single line spacing). Please use the Chicago Footnote system, where sources are cited in numbered footnotes (not in the text).
