## **Launching of the UEM Human Rights Campaign against Discrimination and Exclusion**

Dear sisters and brothers, friends and young people in UEM and UEM Networks,

In these difficult and disturbing times of Covid-19, which affects our lives wherever we live, for the first time the UEM will launch the Human Rights Campaign in a joint online event on 10<sup>th</sup> December (day of human rights) at 11.00 a.m. (Central European Time) in presence of all three UEM Regions.

The campaign “**against discrimination and exclusion**” is headed by the verse from James 4:12 “**But who are you to judge your neighbour?**”

With this question churches and institutions in the UEM communion call upon all Christians, all people of other religious communions and convictions, all governments and political leaders, to fight against discrimination and exclusion and to join hands in building inclusive communities.

In our three regions in Africa, Asia and Germany people face multiple forms of discrimination. This will be featured in a brochure, which will be published together with information and reflections on and initiatives against discrimination.

What makes this UEM campaign special is the joint action of young people in different UEM Member Churches who have taken the lead in concrete actions against discrimination and exclusion.

We like to invite you to this event on 10<sup>th</sup> December.

During the launching we will introduce you to the multimedia campaign and invite you to join by developing your own actions and programs against discrimination for the coming year when UEM is celebrating 25 years of living as international communion of churches and institutions in Mission.
